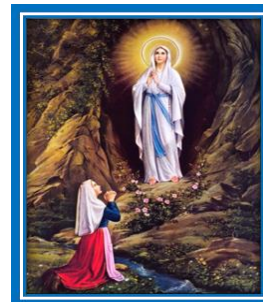
### Our school House Saints

#### Saint Anne



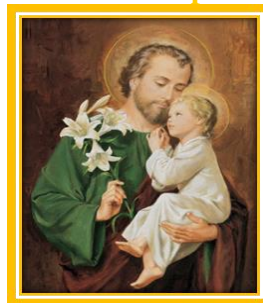
The mother of Mary, the grandmother of Jesus. Married to Saint Joachim. Our school patron saint. Feast day: 26<sup>th</sup> July

#### Saint Bernadette



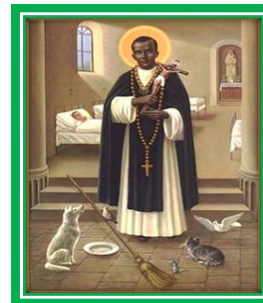
