Finally, I hope you all have a great holiday, find some time to relax and we will see you on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February. Mr Hilton

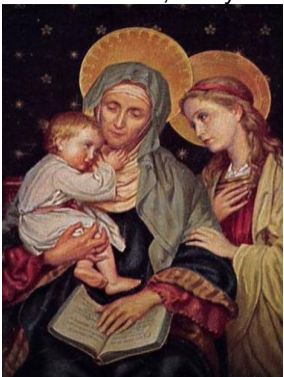
