### LENT

The season of Lent consists of the 40 days, not including Sundays, before Easter. The word Lent is derived from the Germanic root for long because it is observed in spring when the days get longer. Lent is a time to prepare for the holiest time of the Christian year by fasting, praying, almsgiving, and other acts of penance. Many people give up something for Lent (a food, watching TV, etc.) or do something to bring them closer to God such as daily devotions or charitable donations. The church colour for most of Lent is purple which symbolises repentance as well as royalty. The word alleluia is not used during Lent. Here at St Anne's during Lent the children will be given Mission together boxes to support the Pope's own charity for children around the world.
