Headteacher's Weekly Message

Dear Parents and Carers, this weekend we will hear the Gospel of the Good Samaritan. In it, Jesus tells us a powerful story about what it truly means to love our neighbour.

When a man is left hurt on the side of the road, several people pass by without helping. But a Samaritan—a person from a group often looked down upon—stops, tends to the man's wounds, and ensures he is cared for. Jesus ends the story with a clear challenge: "Go and do likewise."

At school and at home, we are always trying to help our children understand what it means to live with compassion. This Gospel reminds us that love is not just a feeling—it's something we *do*, especially when it costs us time, comfort, or convenience.

As families, we are often the first place where this love is learned. When we model patience, kindness, and generosity, especially when it's hard, we show our children how to be modern-day Good Samaritans.

This week, we encourage you to reflect together:

Who are the people in our lives who might need extra kindness?

How can we make space to notice and respond to others with love?

May we all be inspired to "go and do likewise," living out Jesus' call to love with open hearts and helping hands.

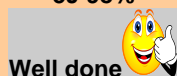
