WINTER UNIFORM

After half term ALL children from Year 1 to Year 6 are expected to wear winter uniform.

Winter Uniform

- Boys Plain blue shirt and tie (no polo shirts)
School sweatshirt with school logo
Grey Long trousers **no unnecessary pockets**
Socks short or long grey/black plain
Shoes plain black
Plain colour woolly hat
- Girls Plain blue blouse and tie (no polo shirts)
School sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo
Plaid kilt
Socks short or long grey/plain grey tights
Shoes plain black
Plain colour woolly hat

Maroon blazers are optional for both boys and girls.

Usual rules apply to earrings (small plain studs only), jewellery, watches, hairstyles and hair baubles. The Uniform Policy is on our school website. (About us – Policies)

In our early Years all children should be wearing their winter uniform as well. Navy jogging/track bottoms, light blue polo shirt and school sweatshirt.

Is your child missing a jacket or other items? Just to remind parents that we have a lost property box next to the cycle covered storage on the KS2 playground. It is overflowing with several warm padded coats, lunch boxes and many other children's items. Please take the time to have a look and see if any of your child's belongings are there, especially before the colder weather begins.

During the half term holiday it might be a good idea to check all your child's uniform to see if their names have faded or maybe add some name labels, that way all items could be returned to the them when misplaced around the school.
