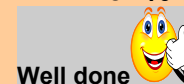

Our goal is to help your child take meaningful first steps in understanding and caring for their mental wellbeing.

### **What is Kooth?**

Kooth is an online platform that provides anonymous, free, and safe mental health support. It offers access to professional counsellors, supportive community features, and helpful self-guided resources.

We hope you will join us in supporting this important initiative to prioritise your child's mental wellness.
