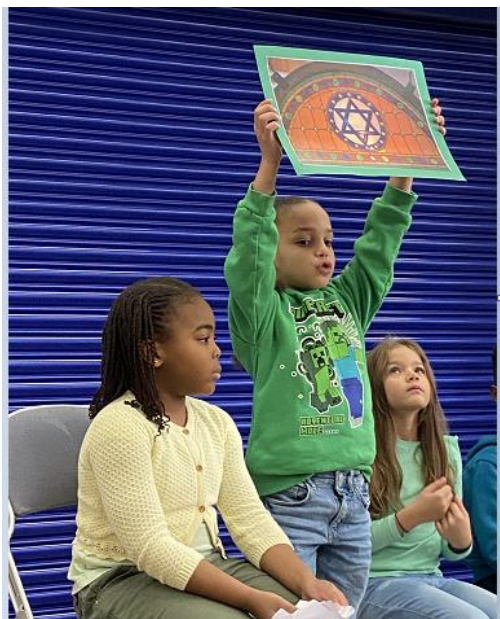
At the start of the year, all children contributed to writing Class rules for their class, to help them to "Let the Light of Christ shine in our school"

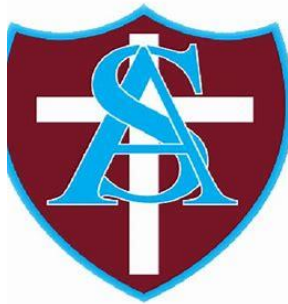




Human Dignity
