We had an excellent take up for the Parents' Evening meetings this term. Thank you to all the parents who came to see their child/children's class teachers.



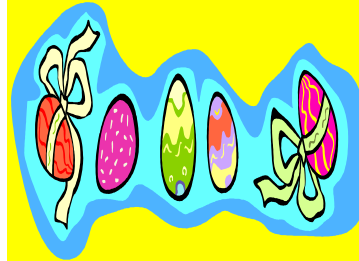
