Children who arrive late

All children should be lining up on the playground before the bell rings at 9am. Children who arrive at school after 9am must be brought into school via the school office where the adult with the child will need to sign them in on the electronic register.

Dropping your child off and not signing them in not only is a safeguarding issue but also delays your child longer from joining in their lessons and they may miss out on vital information that would support their learning.

DO NOT PARK ACROSS THE SCHOOL GATES.

There are road marks and signs asking parents not to park across the school gates when dropping off or collecting your children. Once again, we are reminding parents that the gates need to be free for constant regular access. Yesterday at home time there was 2 cars parked across the gates which prevented access for a carers transport from entering.
