Focus: Time

- O' clock and half past times
- Quarter past and quarter to
- Telling the time to and past the hour

Focus: Statistics

- Tally charts

Focus: Position and Direction

- Positions and turns
- Recognising a whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.
- Recognising and understanding clockwise and anti-clockwise.
- To use language to give directions.

Science

Focus: Making connections – Plant Based Materials

Children will be consolidating knowledge of materials and plant growth through enquiry.

They will identify ways to reduce, recycle and thinking about creative ways to reuse materials according to their suitability.

When working scientifically they will:

- carry out tests to assess the properties of different materials
- use observations to answer questions
- draw conclusions about suitability of materials

Geography

Focus: What is it like to live by the Coast?

We will be focusing on:

- Locating the seas and oceans surrounding the UK
- Explain what the coast is
- Identify the physical and human features of the coast
- Investigate how people use the local coast

RE

Focus: Dialogue and Encounter

Dialogue: Children will hear the parable of the Good Samaritan and consider what it means in the context of Luke's Gospel and Jesus' teaching. The children will reflect on how Christians today can show that they are following in the footsteps of the Good Samaritan.

Encounter: Children will deepen their understanding of Judaism and Islam. They will encounter diversity through artefacts and wherever possible, using personal accounts.
