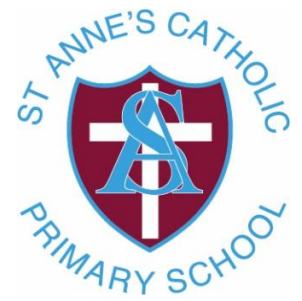

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you of upcoming changes to our school uniform policy, which are intended to provide better value for money for families while continuing to promote a strong sense of pride, belonging and community within our school.

We believe that school uniform plays an important role in supporting equality among pupils, encouraging positive behaviour and readiness to learn, and helping children feel part of our school family.

These changes have been made in line with new statutory guidance on school uniforms and following consultation with both parents and pupils.

From September 2026, the following changes will apply:

We will follow the statutory guidance limiting compulsory branded uniform and PE kit items to a maximum of three. The required branded items will be:

- School jumper or cardigan
- School skirt
- School book bag or backpack

All other compulsory uniform items may be purchased from a range of high street retailers. The school tie will no longer be compulsory to wear.

Please note that the updated policy will be introduced gradually. We do not expect families to replace existing uniform items immediately. Instead, as new uniform items are needed, we ask that any replacements comply with the updated policy.

There will be no changes to the way uniform is ordered.
