Headteacher's Weekly Message

Dear parents and cares, we have a had great response to our school questionnaire. I am just calculating the results and will publish shortly. Our School adviser report was received this week, here are their thoughts on the school and this has been fed back to the Local Authority. This is a friendly and welcoming school, children are fully included

- Although St Anne's has a judgement of RI, the evidence of my initial visit suggests this is no longer the case. There is now a phonics scheme in place which is having impact on learning, all staff are supported in their planning and teaching for children with SEND and leaders are continuing their work in developing subject leaders and full implementation across all foundation subjects.
- The core subjects are well led with clear rationale for choice of schemes and resources.
- Leaders have clear expectations of routines and systems and of what should be available and in use across all classes; there is some further work to do to truly embed these expectations.
- Behaviour for learning is strong across most classes. This means that teachers have the opportunity to expect more learning particularly for children who need some stretch.
- St Anne's particular strength is in inclusion. A strong philosophy of inclusive teaching underpins the implementation of the curriculum.

This really is great news and we are very proud of how far we have come in such a short amount of time. Have a lovely weekend

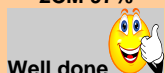
