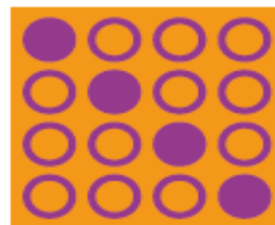
- Free, healthy, and tasty food

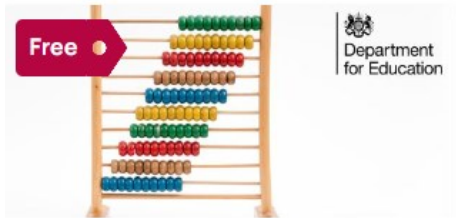
